Propeller Pale Ale 3.5%	330ml	£3.95

Propeller is our session Pale Ale. Inspired by the aviation heritage of our home, it aims to keep you at a cruising altitude with its light, crisp flavour. Do not attempt to operate heavy bombers (or any other machinery) whilst under the influence. Goes well with pies, grilled meats, cheese or just you and a bottle opener.
